- ◆ **May 4 — Mohawk Landing Nature Preserve.** Meet at parking lot on Riverview Rd.
- ◆ **June 1 — William K. Collins Park.** Meet at the parking lot, off of Moe Road. Tour various parks and parkland in the Town Center Area.
