## Historic Grooms Tavern, Clifton Park January 8, 2010 7 p.m.

Explore the Dutch heritage of Clifton Park with Town Historian John Scherer. The first European settlers of the Town of Clifton Park arrived in the late seventeenth century and were children and grandchildren of Dutch families that had originally settled in Albany and Schenectady. Families with Dutch names brought the Dutch culture with them to Clifton Park. Their architecture, furniture, clothing, lifestyle and traditions were distinctly Dutch.



Historic Grooms Tavern is located at the corners of Grooms and Sugarhill roads in Clifton Park. Parking is off of Grooms Road to the rear. Please enter the building from the rear entrance.
