Cost: \$9.00 includes 2 hours bowling, shoe rental and supervision

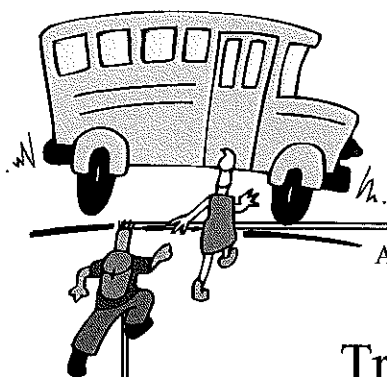
SIGN-UP DEADLINE: Thursday July 8, 2010

We suggest that you apply sunscreen and bug spray on your child before boarding the bus.*
