Sunday Evenings on the Common

- June 20** **Lucky Ticket** - Six members from the Capital Region playing the best in classic rock, country, oldies and more!
- June 27** **Clifton Park Community Chorus** - An energetic, fun-loving multigenerational group of about 45 - 55 participants. Directed by David Rossi with Dian Dippold as Accompanist.
- July 11** **Running the River** - Four piece band whose unique blend of classic Country, Rock, Folk, Irish, Blues, and Fiddle tunes provides entertainment for everyone. In addition to their original songs Running The River performs a wide range of music from artists such as Johnny Cash, the Grateful Dead, Beatles, Kingston Trio, Bob Dylan, the Clancy Brothers, Muddy Waters and the Rolling Stones.
- July 16-18 & July 22-25** **"Once Upon A Mattress"** - Presented by Not So Common Players
Play starts at 7:30 pm
- August 1** **Storm Front - A Billy Joel Tribute Band** - - Sponsored by Price Chopper - Fronted by singer/pianist Mike O'Brien, and backed by his band Storm Front and the Hang em' High horn section, no other act comes closer to recreating the sounds of Billy Joel. Their show consists of playing hit after hit of Joel's musical catalogue with acute accuracy.
