KIDS CAN SHAKE OFF THE WINTER BLUES WITH TWO FUN CAMPS NEXT MONTH

Town offers two programs to run during February school break

The town of Clifton Park is offering two camps this February to help local kids shake off those winter blues during the winter school recess.

- The first, a **Drama Clubhouse**, will run from Monday, Feb. 21 to Friday, Feb. 25 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Locust Lane Clubhouse. The Drama Clubhouse will include singing, acting and dancing for kids ages 8-11. The young actors will have an outlet to express their full range of emotions, and they'll have lots of fun while doing it.

Aside from singing, dancing and acting, the Drama Clubhouse will explore drama techniques including theater games, audition technique, stage presence, set design, costuming and stage make-up. The kids will perform a short musical adaptation for their families at the end of the week. Cost for the 5 five-hour sessions is \$150.

- The second camp during school break is a **Winter Wonderland Recreation Camp** that will be held from Tuesday, Feb. 22 through Friday, Feb. 25 at Historic Grooms Tavern. The morning session will run from 9:00 to 11:30 a.m. and the afternoon session will run from 1:30 to 4:00 p.m.

The winter recreation camp will include activities such as create-a-bear, games, crafts and karaoke. A clown or magician may even stop by! The camp is open to Clifton Park residents ages 5-10. Children must be 5 by January 1, 2011. The cost of either the morning or afternoon half-day camp session is \$40.
