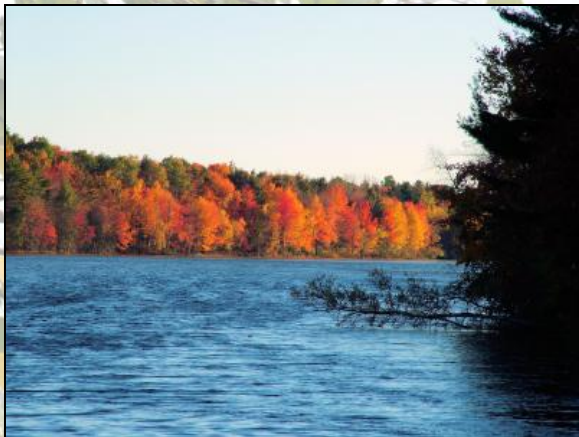
Launch a Canoe or Kayak
