CLIFTON PARK TOWN HALL A DROP-OFF LOCATION FOR “BOOKS FOR TROOPS” PROGRAM

Town Hall is a drop-off location for the “Books for Troops” program, an effort by local volunteers to collect donations of paperback, comic and puzzle books to send to members of the military who are serving overseas.

Many combat troops are on the move most of the day. Lightweight and portable reading material provides an escape and small respite from their daily duties. The program sponsored by Operation Adopt A Soldier and is being coordinated by Books for Troops manager Ellen Keegan.

The collection box will remain in the front lobby of town hall near the reception desk from now until the end of the year. Keegan reminds donors that all reading materials with photographs and drawings should be acceptable to the host country’s cultural values.
