Re: Roadway Reconstruction Project

We would like to inform you of our plans to reconstruct Plaid Place and Damask Drive. Also, Gingham Drive will receive a new overlay of asphalt to repair its deteriorated condition.

Our contractor will begin on Monday morning, September 28th with a milling process to remove four inches of existing pavement and then grade and compact to establish the new base of the roadways. This will provide proper contours to shed storm water into the new drain system. This process will be done on the entire lengths of both Plaid Place and Damask Drive. Contingent on any major complications it should be completed by Friday October 2nd. It will be noisy and possibly dusty, so we ask that you bear with the crews and keep away from the operations.

The paving operations should begin on Monday October 5th. A dense binder course will be applied first, then followed will a top course for the driving surface. On each side will be beveled wing curbs, which will channel storm water to the storm grates. The entire project should be finished by Friday October 9th.

We appreciate your patience with the progress of this major undertaking. We look forward the completion of the work which will finally provide you with a well constructed, smooth roadway. I have spoken with many of you regarding through traffic and excessive speeds. We will implement measures necessary to provide for a safe, tranquil neighborhood. Thank you.
