INFORMATION REGARDING ANNUAL LEAVES AND GRASS PICKUP

County Waste recently sent a letter to all its customers regarding some changes in the way leaves and grass will be picked up this year. Through an agreement with the town of Clifton Park, every homeowner in the town is eligible for this pickup. Since non-customers did not receive this letter, town officials want to be sure that this information is posted for everyone to see.

County waste began picking up yard leaves and grass starting the week of Monday, March 30 and will continue to do so through the end of November. Waste pick-up days will be every Monday, Tuesday or Friday. Leaves and grass must be placed in brown paper bags only. No yard waste will be collected from garbage cans.

Anyone with questions about the pick-up of leaves and grass should call County Waste at 877-7007. The pick-up of leaves and grass is separate from the town's ice storm debris pick-up schedule. County Waste will not be picking up ice storm debris – trees and limbs downed by the ice storm will be picked up by town contractors or Highway Department crews.
