“PLANT A TREE FOR A NEWBORN” PROGRAM KICKS OFF ARBOR DAY CELEBRATION

As part of its Arbor Day celebration, the town of Clifton Park is pleased to announce its annual “Plant A Tree For The Newborn” Program. The Town offers a free tree seedling to all Clifton Park families who have had a baby born between Arbor Day 2009 and Arbor Day 2010.

The only requirements for this program are that the parents live in Clifton Park, the babies are born between April 24, 2009 and April 30, 2010 and the families register their newborn with the town at the Office of Parks, Recreation and Community Affairs located in Town Hall. Deadline for registration is April 1, 2010 unless your child is born between April 2 and April 30, 2010.

The week after Arbor Day 2010, May 3 - 7, parents can come to Clifton Park Town Hall and pick up a free seedling tree to be planted on their property as a “birth tree” for the child. Also during that week, the babies’ pictures will be displayed at Town Hall.

The hope is that these trees will grow up with the child and add to the child’s appreciation of nature and the conservation of wildlife. Town officials hope that as the children watch their “birth trees” grow, they will become citizens who care about the environment.
