TOWN SETS WORKSHOPS, SURVEY FOR RECREATION MASTER PLAN

Clifton Park, NY – The town of Clifton Park is preparing a Recreation Master Plan to evaluate the recreational needs of current and future residents and will hold two workshops and offer a survey to obtain feedback from the public.

“As the community grows, it is important to consider the recreational needs for all residents,” Councilman Tom Paolucci said. “The Recreation Master Plan will identify the existing and future recreation needs of the town and how to best meet those needs.”

All residents, property owners, civic groups, business owners, community leaders and anyone else interested are welcome to participate in one of the workshops. Middle- and high school-aged children are welcome to attend these workshops as well.

The format will include a presentation on the purpose of the plan followed by a facilitated discussion in small groups. Additional workshops will be held in the fall of 2009. All comments and feedback will be recorded and used to guide recreational decisions in the town.
