CLIFTON PARK G.R.E.E.N. COMMITTEE TO HOST NATIONAL GRID Q&A
Smart Energy Solutions Program for Town Residents

On Thursday, March 16, 2017 the Town of Clifton Park's G.R.E.E.N. Committee will host National Grid for a presentation of the new Smart Energy Solutions program for Town residents. Smart Energy Solutions is a National Grid program developed for Clifton Park electric and natural gas customers to allow them to better manage their energy use and potentially save money.

As part of Smart Energy Solutions, National Grid will be installing new electric and natural gas meters to provide customers with near real-time insights into their energy use. Using this information, residents will be able to determine which electric price plan is best for them, choose energy-efficiency improvements, such as insulation and lighting and receive high bill alerts among other consumer benefits.

National Grid representatives will be available to answer questions about Smart Energy Solutions including resident's eligibility in the program, how to enroll, the new meter installation process and how to determine which electric price plan is appropriate.
