## **ANNOUNCEMENTS AND COMMUNICATION**

Supervisor Barrett thanked all town employees, major sponsors County Waste, Twin Bridges and Prestige Services and participants of the July 4<sup>th</sup> vehicle parade for their participation.

Supervisor Barrett announced all planned concerts series on The Clifton Common through July are cancelled. August concerts are still to be determined.

Supervisor Barrett explained a "streaming only" concert fundraiser, to benefit the Community Action Fund, is in the planning stages. He explained the Community Action Fund benefits many organizations in the community.

Supervisor Barrett stated the town has opened 2 of the town pools, Burning Bush and Barney Road. Secure and safe precautions are in place according to NYS mandates. He thanked all employees who participated in the opening of the pools and the lifeguards for adjusting to the new safety regulations.

Supervisor Barrett explained the town has begun full day camps and continues to offer as many recreational opportunities as possible under safe conditions and will continue to be the town's goal for the summer and into the fall season.

WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes the environmental, planning and policy objectives met by approving water service over alternative plans; now, therefore, be it

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to provide a modified fee schedule for the town pools for the 2020 season, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 153-16 of Town Code, provides the authority to establish membership fees for the town pools, and

WHEREAS, the Town Supervisor recommends that a daily rate be set at \$5 per person, and the guidelines in Schedule A, 2020 Town Pool Operations, be adopted for the 2020 pool season; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the fees and operating guidelines for the 2020 pool season be adopted effective July 4, 2020.
