

What Else Should I Know about This Program?

- R. U. OK? Is a FREE service.**
But is not a guarantee of services of any kinds.
- When the phones are out the *Citizen Corps Council* and the *CERT Team* have a back-up network in place to reach participants.
- All completed applications will be distributed to your local Fire and Ambulance service.
- The **Registry Database** will be overlaid onto the Town's computerized GIS (*Geographic Information System*) and each **R. U. OK?** home will be clearly identified.
- Each participant will receive written confirmation of receipt of their application.
- The database will be updated upon participant's written request or at least annually.



Points to Ponder:

Do you have a medication list?

- In a safe, secure place?
- Is it current? Updated?
- Easily accessible to Emergency Responders?
- In a "Vial of Life"?



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

What is the R. U. OK? Program?



Neighbors – Helping Neighbors

It is a completely voluntary new program designed to enhance public safety. All emergencies begin and end locally. In the aftermath of 9-11, officials in the U.S. Department of Homeland Security endorsed local efforts to assist residents obtain emergency services.

R. U. OK? provides personalized, confidential information, through a Town maintained database, to local Fire, Police and EMS. This enables Emergency Services to respond appropriately to those residents requiring special consideration.

Who Will Benefit From This Program?

- Anyone with **limited mobility**.
- Anyone who is **hearing impaired**.
- Anyone who is **vision impaired**.
- Anyone who is **speech-impaired, non-verbal**.
- Anyone with a **physical disability**.
- Independent seniors**, living at home, without family in the area.
- Anyone having **special requirements** should a localized evacuation be necessary.
- Any household member with a **mental or emotional disability** that might impair their ability to help themselves or understand the nature of the emergency.



Criteria to Participate in R. U. OK?

- Must live in Clifton Park
- Must live at home, not in a licensed facility.

Join R. U. OK? Today! (Are You OK?)

- 1 Sign-Up** – Register your specific situation, or that of a family member in a confidential database, designed to aid our police, fire and emergency medical responders in meeting your individual needs.
- 2 Confidentiality** – Is guaranteed. The information you provide is confidential and only available to trained volunteers.
- 3** Consider the value of the “**Call & Contact**” Check-In list. During an emergency or disaster a volunteer will call you to be sure you and your home are safe and secure.
